

The **Kalinga Fellowship** is a programme that brings together progressive leaders from business, government and civil society to facilitate breakthroughs in thinking and action in combatting human trafficking.

2022-2023 FOCUS

How can the leaders of government, business and civil society come together to combat human trafficking in South Asia?

This is a one-year programme, starting 1st November 2022, with a five-day breakthrough event in Bhubaneswar, Odisha, India, 12th – 16th December 2022.

The Streams

There are seven dedicated streams centred around key breakthrough solutions. These solutions have been proven to move the needle on combatting human trafficking.

- 1. The Power of Technology and Data** – to progress the usage and impact of this first truly multi-sector information sharing platform. **Strategic partners:** IBM & Traffik Analysis Hub.
- 2. Purpose-led Corporates** – to bring the leaders of corporates together to unleash the power of business in combatting human trafficking. **Strategic partner:** Halotrade.
- 3. Zero Tolerance to Child Marriage** – to enrol millions of young people in creating a zero tolerance to child marriage. **Strategic partners:** Mission Better Tomorrow & the Government of Odisha.
- 4. Next Generation Policing** – to implement the very best global practices of policing across the whole police force. **Strategic partners:** Kerala and Odisha Police, Mission Better Tomorrow and the Student Police Cadets.
- 5. The First Responder** – to roll out an awareness to last-mile families and communities across South Asia of the true nature of human trafficking. **Strategic partner:** FXB India Suraksha.
- 6. Transforming Education** – to educate boys and girls on all they can do in building a world with gender equality. **Strategic partner:** the Kalinga Institute of Social Sciences and the Government of Odisha.
- 7. Reintegrating Survivors** - To enhance the lives of survivors within their communities. **Strategic partner:** Self-Employed Women's Association (SEWA)

The 12-Month Programme

Each stream will embark on a 12-month programme, implementing breakthrough solutions throughout South Asia. The programme starts 1st November 2022.

The programme teaches and utilises progressive leadership and strategy tools. It is facilitated by experts from **BRIDGE** and the **Bridge Institute**.

Each delegate will be supported and trained to transform their personal agency, mindsets, behaviours and capabilities to develop their capacity for societal leadership.
